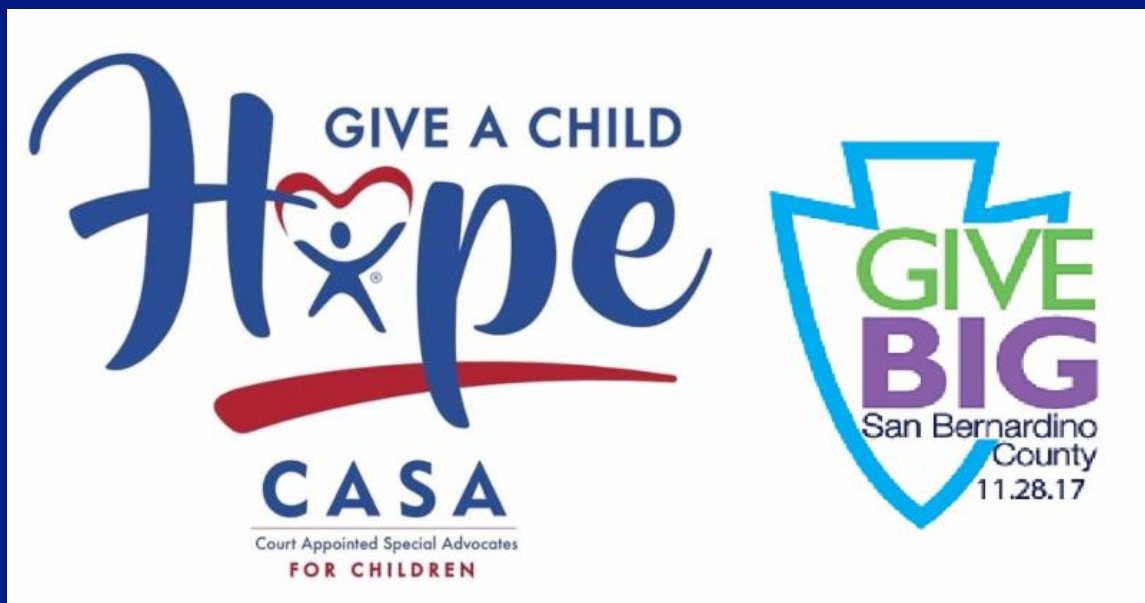


Find out what C.A.S.A. has been up to!

We recruit, screen, train, and supervise passionate community volunteers LIKE YOU to mentor and advocate for foster youth in the child welfare system, in the health care system, in the education system, and in every day life situations. The youth that you will have an opportunity to impact are those that have little to no family connections, those who will age out of the system, those that have a learning disability and or behavioral and or mental health challenges, those that have endured severe abuse and neglect, those that are pregnant and or parenting, those that are at risk of dropping out of school, those that do not have an Educational Rights Holder to make decisions for their academic success, simply put, those that have lost hope. As a C.A.S.A. volunteer you will develop a genuine relationship that not only challenges, inspires, and motivates your youth, but you will also serve as their voice, helping them overcome the challenges of living in foster care to ensure that they receive the proper care and interventions to flourish despite the odds

He asked me if I could work on getting his friends a CASA, because he could tell they were sad that they didn't get one today! I told him I would let the office know that there are more boys who would like to have their own CASA. He took me to two more houses after you left and introduced me to the staff and some of the other boys. He then walked me back to the main office, and then gave me a big hug when I left. I told him I would see him next week, so he is looking forward to that!
